

INTRODUCTION FOR CONFERENCES AND WORKSHOPS

PROFESSOR SOHAIL INAYATULLAH

Professor Sohail Inayatullah is a political scientist/futurist associated with Tamkang University, Taiwan (Graduate Institute for Futures Studies), University of the Sunshine Coast (Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences), and Prout College (proutcollege.org). In 1999, Inayatullah held the UNESCO Chair at the Centre for European Studies, University of Trier, Germany and was David Sutton Fellow with the International Management Centre. He is co-editor of the *Journal of Futures Studies*.

Along with authoring and co-editing twenty books and cdroms (such as *Macrohistory and Macrohistorians*, *Questioning the Future*, *the University in Transformation*, *Youth Futures*, and *Alternative Educational Futures*) Inayatullah is theme editor of 'Globalization and World Systems' for the UNESCO *Encyclopedia of Life Support Systems*. He has written more than 300 journal articles, book chapters, encyclopedia entries and magazine essays. These have appeared in over 40 different journals and have been translated into a variety of languages, including Catalan, Spanish, Urdu, Hindi, Bengali, Italian, Japanese, Russian, and Mandarin.

In the past few years he has given keynote, plenary, or public lectures on a range of subjects in Turkey, Austria, Luxembourg, Thailand, Singapore, the Philippines, Thailand, New Zealand, Canada, the United States, Pakistan, Malaysia, Holland, Australia, Yugoslavia, Greece, India, Germany, Switzerland, Taiwan, and Japan.

In Australia, along with presentations to the corporate sector (for example, Ernst and Young, Bluescope Steel, Fuji Xerox Australia, Telstra Countrywide, Boeing Australia) and local (Brisbane, Gold Coast, Maroochy and Logan shires), state (Qld Ministries of Education, Health, Transport, Main roads, Treasury) and federal departments of government (Australian Federal Police, Australia Biosecurity, Department of Defence), he has conducted futures workshops for dozens of educational organizations and corporations. He has also run Futures-Oriented Policy courses and visioning projects for Maroochy Shire Council, Brisbane City Council, Queensland Tourism, Racing and Fair Trade, the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Farming (Division of Animal Welfare and Product Integrity), Gold Coast Council and Logan City Council.
